

AWF 2.1 Feature Overview

- Multi-Site and Multi-Language support
- Changes can be made on a preview site and published at a later time on the live site
- Content versioning
- LDAP support for user authorization and retrieving of user profiles
- Built-in Wiki engine with a powerful and extensible syntax (PEAR::Text_Wiki)
- Fully flexible URLs, which allow existing static Web sites to be replaced
- Very fast caching, which means very good performance even on old servers
- Link management (central database for external links)
- User and Group Management
- Users can be exported in various formats, like HTML, CVS and XML
- Includes a logfile analyzer
- Designed for PHP 5, that means most of the code is object-oriented and quite fast
- Based on open standards for PHP development like the Smarty template engine
- Includes Spaw WYSIWYG Editor (1.1 RC1)
- Flexible permissions system
- Community Portal functions (online list, forums, instant messages, newsletters, weblogs, wiki,...)
- Image upload, browser and galleries (Digital Asset Management)
- RSS support
- XML and PDF export for all documents
- Content Integration using RSS, AWF-XML and Mediawiki as sources (more to come)
- Validated XHTML templates
- Integrated category and license management
- Auto repair function for database tables
